Dear Parent/Guardian

Over the last half term, we have been impressed with students' improved conduct and positive attitudes to their learning. Staff have been reminding our students that we have high expectations and reinforcing our Beal Campus Expectations. Many thanks for reinforcing these messages at home and supporting us in ensuring your child is 'dressed for success' so we can ensure the highest standards of uniform.

As we head into the winter, some students may start to wear hoodies inside the building. Hoodies are not suitable for a formal working environment and are not part of our school uniform and will be confiscated.

The following is also a list of things that that we think will serve as a timely reminder, as the half term will provide some time to ensure that your child has all the school clothing they need.

- Girls' trousers should be smart tailored trousers (no jeans)
- Girls' skirts should be knee length
- Trousers should not be worn low at the waist
- Students should wear ties and the top collar button done up
- Blazers should be worn to school every day
- Shoes should not be of trainer/plimsoll design
- Nails should not be coloured and nail extensions should not be worn. They will need to be removed as they pose a health and safety risk
- Hooded jackets cannot be worn inside the school buildings
- Hoodies cannot be worn at any time. Students should wear black V-neck jumpers. Hoodies will be confiscated by members of staff
- 6th form students must ensure they are wearing their ID lanyards at all times
- Mobile devices and headphones should not be seen or heard in school, unless a teacher has given express permission for students to use these for educational purposes. Sixth Formers may use their devices in the Sixth Form areas only.
- For habitual offenders or those that refuse to put their phones away we will confiscate their devices. If your son or daughter brings a phone or headphones to school, they must ensure they are out of sight before they arrive.

Please can you remind your child/children about the Beal High School uniform policy and ensure they are appropriately dressed when they return to school after half term.


