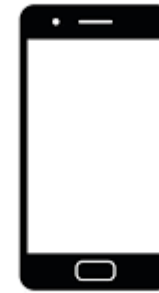
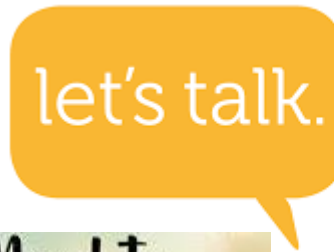
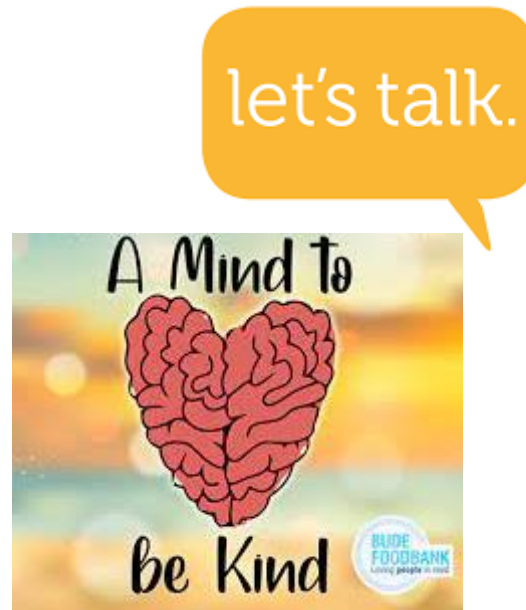

- The following week you will find out the overall result of how other schools in the country voted






- This platform is what most teachers will use to set you homework.

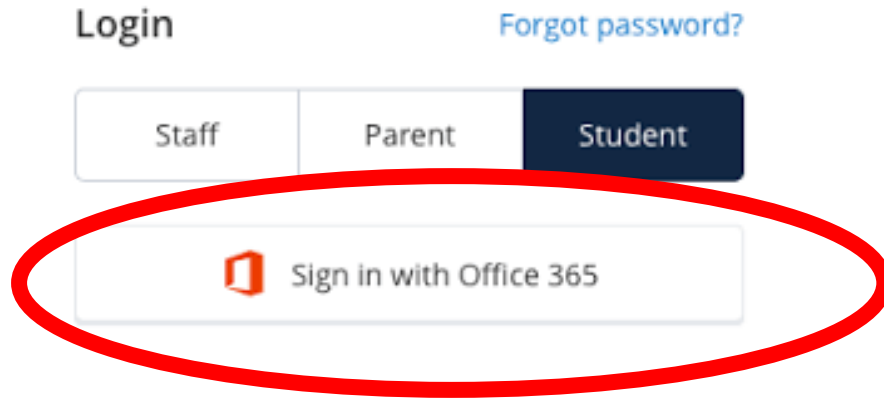

On days where they have PE, they should bring their PE kits with them


